

Leader's Guide

The **100⁺¹ Challenge** is your chance to celebrate, participate, and share in the fun and excitement of the Centennial Celebration of the Boy Scouts of America. The requirements are simple:

- 1. Participate in 100 days of Scouting from October 17, 2009 to October 17, 2010
- 2. Recruit one other person to join Scouting to share the fun with you!

Your youth and adult members can participate simply by attending den, pack, patrol, troop, team, or crew meetings. They can even count working on an activity pin with their parents or working on a merit badge. Any activity can count especially things like going camping, selling popcorn, and working on service projects. Sounds easy doesn't it?

Each youth and adult member should be provided with a copy of the commitment form included with this guide. There are electronic forms available at www.100years.danbeard.org These forms will stay at the unit level and only the **Unit Completion Form** will be sent to the Scout Achievement Center

This should be a simple program to administer on the unit level. We are accepting on Scout's Honor, that you have reviewed each individual's submission and have accepted their level of participation as having met or surpassed the requirement.

The **Unit Completion Form** does require that the name of each person recruited be entered into the appropriate fields. These names will be verified for registration purposes upon receipt of your unit's submission.

For instant recognition a downloadable certificate, complete with fill in the blank fields is available as individuals complete the challenge at www.100years.danbeard.org. Patches will be available to purchase after 1/25/10. A special recognition is being planned for the Arena Show at the 2010 Peterloon, so work with your unit members to be done by then and join us at this special event! You will have to the end of the 2010 calendar year to complete the challenge, but the big party will be at Peterloon, so we'll see you there!

To order the 100⁺¹ Challenge patch you must submit a Unit Completion Form no later than 12/31/10. Unit Completion Forms can be turned in and patches ordered through the Scout Achievement Center beginning 1/25/2010.
